



UNIFORM STANDARD

All students are expected to wear correct College approved uniform. Parents are asked to support the College by ensuring that their children leave and arrive home dressed in the correct uniform. If in extraordinary circumstances a student is unable to wear correct uniform, the parent/guardian should write an explanatory note in the student's Record Book or contact the students Home Group teacher.

All uniforms specified in the uniform standard are compulsory unless otherwise stated.

SUMMER AND WINTER UNIFORMS

Summer uniform must be worn in Terms 1 and 4. The official College wide brimmed blue hat is compulsory in these terms and must be worn when the student is outside. Winter uniform must be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Due to the changes in weather, there is a two week transition period from summer to winter uniform in Term Two.

UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS

- Religious jewelry is permitted
- Nail polish is not be worn
- Only Senior students are permitted to wear minimal and discreet makeup.
- Hair color must be of a natural shade as deemed suitable by Newhaven College. If parents are unsure please contact appropriate Head of School
- Hair styles should complement the College's traditional uniform
- All students must have hair that falls on the shoulders tied back at all times (navy, maroon or white ties, ribbons or clips are permitted)
- Males are not permitted to wear beards, moustaches or accentuated side burns
- Only College approved badges are to be worn
- Year 12 students may only wear College approved Year 12 tops during the approved time of the year as directed by the Head of Senior School
- Socks should be worn above the ankle at all times – boys must wear the school socks, and when the girls socks are introduced in the middle of Term One 2019, then these will be compulsory.
- Sports socks are only to be worn with the sports uniform
- The student's name should be on all items of uniform
- T Shirts or other items of clothing worn as undergarments must not be visible

EAR AND FACIAL PIERCINGS

The rules relating to earrings, nose, eyebrow and labret studs are as follows:

- Earrings: A student may wear a maximum of two discreet earrings or studs in each ear
- Nose Studs: A student may wear a single, small and discreet nose stud (not ring)
- Eyebrow Studs: A student may wear a single, small and discreet eyebrow stud (not ring)
- Labret Studs: A small discreet labret stud may be worn
- Only one facial stud may be worn, for example students may not wear a nose stud and eyebrow stud simultaneously

Students who are deemed to be wearing indiscreet earrings or ear, nose and eyebrow studs will be required to remove the item.

The College will determine what is, or is not, discreet.

Physical Education Uniform

Correct Physical Education Uniform is compulsory for all students in Prep to Year 12. The College pullover is not permitted to be worn with the Physical Education Uniform. All items must be school approved Physical Education Uniform.

Only the school leggings can be worn.

House Sports Uniform

The official House Polo Shirt must be worn at all designated House Events with the College navy blue shorts or tracksuit pants.

Bags and Accessories

- Newhaven College school bags are compulsory
- Newhaven College library bags are compulsory for Years Prep to 4

Optional

- Newhaven College sports bags
- Newhaven College pencil case

JUNIOR SCHOOL UNIFORM (Prep – Year 4)

Boys Summer Uniform:

- Elastic waisted grey College shorts or trousers (optional)
- Open neck short sleeved shirt with school emblem – worn out over the waist of the shorts
- Long dark blue socks banded at the top, with shorts. Dark socks beneath long trousers
- The College pullover must be worn as the outer garment
- Shoes must be black, leather and lace up or velcro with a traditional heel

Boys Winter Uniform:

- Elastic waisted grey College shorts or trousers
- The College long sleeved shirt tucked in. The official College skivvy can be worn instead of a shirt
- Dark socks beneath long trousers
- Long dark blue socks banded at the top, when wearing shorts
- The College pullover must be worn as the outer garment
- Shoes must be black, leather and lace up or Velcro with a traditional heel

Optional

- Official College navy scarf (winter only)
- The official Junior School College jacket over their pullover when outside and to and from school (all year)
- Navy blue beanie (winter only)
- Newhaven College raincoat can be worn to and from school over the pullover

Girls Summer Uniform:

- Girls can wear the summer College dress or shorts and blouse to be introduced in mid Term One 2019.
- The College pullover must be worn as the outer garment
- Dresses with a hemline on or below the knee
- Girls must have plain white socks worn above the ankle and below the knee. Official girls banded socks will be introduced in mid Term One 2019.
- Shoes must be black leather and have a traditional heel. They can be lace up, velcro or have a buckle (e.g. T-bar sandal).

Girls Winter Uniform:

- The official College pinafore or navy girls' pants can be worn.
- The College long sleeved shirt tucked in. The official College skivvy can be worn instead of a shirt
- Official navy banded girls' socks or navy tights.
- The College pullover must be worn as the outer garment
- Shoes must be black leather and have a traditional heel. They can be lace up, velcro or have a buckle (e.g. T-bar sandal).

Optional

- Official College navy scarf (winter only)
- The official Junior School College jacket over their pullover when outside and to and from school (all year)

Junior School Physical Education Uniform

- The Junior School Sports uniform is to be worn to and from school on designated sports days
- Newhaven College navy sport shorts
- Newhaven College sports polo
- Plain white sport socks
- Appropriate sports shoes or sneakers
- College Junior fleecy jumper

Optional

- College Junior fleecy tracksuit pants
- Navy blue beanie (winter only)
- Newhaven College raincoat can be worn to and from school over the pullover

YEAR 9 ENVIRONMENTAL CENTRE UNIFORM GUIDELINES

The Year 9 Uniform is the same uniform for the whole year:

- Newhaven College Year 9 shorts
- Newhaven College Year 9 shirt
- Newhaven College Year 9 blue long sleeved polar fleece is to be worn as the outer garment
- Dark blue socks (cotton or wool)
- Footwear as per distributed guidelines (contact the Year 9 Environmental Centre for details)

Optional

- Newhaven College Year 9 long pants
- The College polar fleece vest

MIDDLE AND SENIOR COLLEGE UNIFORM (Years 5-8 and 10-12)

Blazers

Newhaven College Middle and Senior School students (except Year 9) are required to wear the College Blazer with the summer and winter uniform. This includes wearing the blazer to and from school. Blazers do not have to be worn on days when the forecast is over 30°C

Boys Summer Uniform:

- The College blazer
- Tailored grey College shorts or trousers
- Open neck short sleeved shirt with school emblem – worn out over the waist of the shorts but tucked in if it hangs below the blazer
- Long dark blue socks banded at the top with shorts. Dark socks beneath long trousers
- The College pullover
- Shoes must be black, leather and lace up with a traditional heel

Boys Winter Uniform:

- The College blazer
- Tailored grey College trousers or shorts (Dark socks beneath long trousers)
- The College long sleeved shirt tucked in
- The College tie
- Long dark blue socks banded at the top when wearing shorts
- The College pullover
- Shoes must be black, leather and lace up with a traditional heel

Optional:

- Official College navy scarf (winter only)
- The official navy College raincoat may be worn over the Blazer to and from the College (all year)

Girls Summer Uniform:

- The College blazer
- Girls can wear the summer College dress or shorts and blouse to be introduced in mid Term One 2019. Dresses should have their hemline on or below the knee
- The College pullover
- Girls must have plain white socks worn above the ankle and below the knee. From mid Term One 2019 they must wear the official College banded girls' white socks
- Shoes must be black leather and have a traditional heel. They can be lace up, velcro or have a buckle (e.g. T-bar sandal).

Girls Winter Uniform:

- The College blazer
- The College winter skirt or the College navy girls' pants with dark socks underneath
- Skirts must be worn with a hemline at knee length or below
- The College long sleeved shirt tucked in
- The College tie
- The College pullover
- Girls can wear navy tights or the College banded navy girls' sock.
- Shoes must be black leather and have a traditional heel. They can be lace up, velcro or have a buckle (e.g. T-bar sandal).

Optional

- Official College navy scarf (winter only)
- The official navy College raincoat may be worn over the Blazer to and from the College (all year)

Middle and Senior School Physical Education Uniform

Students in the Middle and Senior School are required to change into their sports uniform at school. It is not permitted to be worn to and from school unless directed by the Head of School.

- College navy sport shorts
- College sports polo
- Plain white sport socks
- Appropriate sports shoes

Optional

- College tracksuit pants
- College rugby jumper
- College sports jacket
- College leggings
