SIBLING DISCOUNTS

Newhaven College offers generous sibling discounts to keep costs affordable for families.

The fees that Newhaven College receives from parents are an important conduit for providing the resources, staffing and facilities that benefit your students. Their prompt receipt allows the college to function seamlessly and ensures future fee increases are kept to a minimum.

As an enrolment condition parents are expected to pay all their tuition and sundry fee charges as, and when, they fall due. Tuition fees and bus fees (if applicable) are charged annually and are due for payment by the end of **Week 2, Term 1**⁴. Payment by this date allows families to benefit from a \$180 discount (per student) on their annual tuition fees⁵.

CAN FEES STILL BE PAID EACH TERM?

Yes. Plus, families opting to pay each term will benefit from a \$25 discount (per student) on their term payment⁶, if paid by the due date. Term payment dates for 2021 are as follows;

Term 1	Friday 05 February 2021
Term 2	Friday 23 April 2021
Term 3	Friday 23 July 2021
Term 4	Friday 08 October 2021

Families do not need to formally opt for this method. Instead, payment must be received into the College's bank account by the applicable term payment date to qualify.

¹ Tuition and Bus fees are reviewed annually.

² Year 12 students are expected to pay the bus fee for the whole year, regardless of whether they drive themselves later in the year, as the fees are costed per seat.

³ Prep to Year 6 tuition fees are inclusive of the book levy and ensemble music lessons.

⁴ Students commencing after the start of the school year will receive a ten (10) school-day grace period from the date of billing.

⁵ Does not include Private Music, Bus, or any other sundry fees. Subsidised Tuition fees will only receive the discount on the Tuition fee less any discounts already applied. Family accounts must be fully paid to receive this discount.

⁶ Conditions apply as per the annual tuition fee discount.

LATE PAYMENT CHARGE

A late payment charge of \$30 will be added to each family's account (per term) if fees remain unpaid after the applicable term payment date. Families who have agreed payment instalments will not be charged the late payment fee unless a default is made on those agreed payments within the school term.

WORKPAY SCHEME

The College Board has decided not to proceed with the WorkPay Scheme for 2021 and beyond. This is a \$100 saving per families each year.

PAYMENT METHODS

Fees may be paid via BPAY®, EFTPOS (including credit/debit cards), cash, or cheque.

PAYSMART – REGULARLY SCHEDULED PAYMENTS

We wish to support our families who need to make regular payments, so we have formed a partnership with PaySmart™ who will manage this process on behalf of the College⁷. Application forms are available from Accounts.

STUDENT WITHDRAWAL

As outlined in the Terms and Conditions of Enrolment a full term's notice must be given when withdrawing a student. If this does not occur, then the next term's fees will be charged.
