Shape of the Day 2023

In our efforts to provide the best learning environment possible for all our students in 2023, we have undergone a review of the shape of our school day. After extensive consultation and feedback, we will be modifying the time allocated to classes.

In 2023 we will be moving to four 75-minute periods per day – away from the current six 48-minute periods. We believe this change will create the opportunity for better learning, including more practical and hands on activities, more time for community and school events, less movement during the day and greater certainty. The plan is to remove double periods – all periods will be the same. We also want to give students no less than five minutes of movement time between classes. Ultimately, we hope this change creates better opportunities for student learning, care and extra-curricular activities.
