THE JOURNEY TO OUR NEW UNIFORM

The story of Newhaven College's uniform is a journey through time, reflecting the school's evolution and enduring commitment to excellence. It all began in the 1980s when the school's colours were chosen to reflect our location on Phillip Island - navy blue, sky blue and maroon. The colours represented the sea, sky and the red coloured rocks off the coast of the township of Newhaven. The Foundation Students of 1980, wore skirts, pants, shorts and summer dresses not that dissimilar to today, with a more casual college jumper, a pale blue windcheater with the original College crest.

The original Newhaven College crest and motto are still part of the school's identity. The original Royal Spoonbill, drawn by renowned ornithologist Graham Pizzey, the ecumenical symbol of a cross in a boat and the scroll inscribed with the school motto 'In Quietness and Confidence Shall Be Your Strength' (Isaiah 30:15), still being an important connection to Newhaven College's origins. The current branding is simpler, lighter and more contemporary while still embracing the past.

As the years unfolded, the uniform saw changes and adaptations. The 1990s marked a significant transformation with the introduction of blazers, ties and various accessories that reflected the school's spirit. Newhaven College is now introducing a new chapter in its uniform history.

Elements of the current uniform will be phased out in favour of a fresh design, symbolising the school's commitment to high-quality education in a nurturing environment.

Our new uniform isn't just a change in branding and clothing - it's an embodiment of the school's enduring pride and its students' dedication to the Newhaven College community. As we move forward, let's celebrate the rich history that has brought us to this moment and look ahead to the exciting future that awaits.
