All applications will be reviewed by a panel and those short listed will be invited for an interview. A final decision in relation to short listed applicants will be made on the basis of an interview and will take into account the range of listed achievements and level of community involvement and contributions across all areas of College and community.

CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN TO:

- Demonstrated blend of interests.
- School report and level of achievement and attitude in academic studies.
- Additional factors which will affect selection will include interest and acceptance of the curricular and co-curricular program of Newhaven College and sympathy with the ethos and aims of the College.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. The College reserves the right not to offer Scholarships if the standard of the applicants does not warrant it doing so. The Principal has discretion as to the number and monetary amount of all Scholarships.
2. The College will not enter into a dispute regarding the awarding of the Scholarships.
3. Parents and students are informed that it is a condition of a Scholarship being awarded that the **amount** of the Scholarship remains confidential between the family and the College. If offered a Scholarship, parents will be required to sign a form to this effect.
4. Recipients of scholarships are expected to maintain satisfactory academic progress, to take an active part in the various co-curricular activities offered and, in particular, to make a significant contribution to the life of the College.
5. Scholarships are for the duration of a student's education at Secondary level.
6. Scholarships are reviewed annually and may be reduced or terminated if a recipient's progress, attitude or conduct is considered unsatisfactory.
7. Scholarships may also be reviewed should a family's compliance with the College's Terms and Conditions of Enrolment be considered unsatisfactory.
8. The information on the application form, results of tests (if any), interviews and any information about the financial position of parents is strictly confidential.
9. Peter Reith Scholarship interviews will be held at the College. Applicants will be short listed for interview and not all applicants may be interviewed.
10. An invitation to attend an interview does not mean that the student will be offered a scholarship. Following the interview process, offers will be made in writing by the Principal. Any offers of scholarships not accepted by the due date will be rescinded.
11. Scholarships will attract a reduction in tuition fees only.
12. Students already attending Newhaven College in 2024 are eligible to apply. Students who have submitted an enrolment application form to Newhaven College are also eligible to apply.
13. Scholarships are not available to overseas full fee-paying students.
